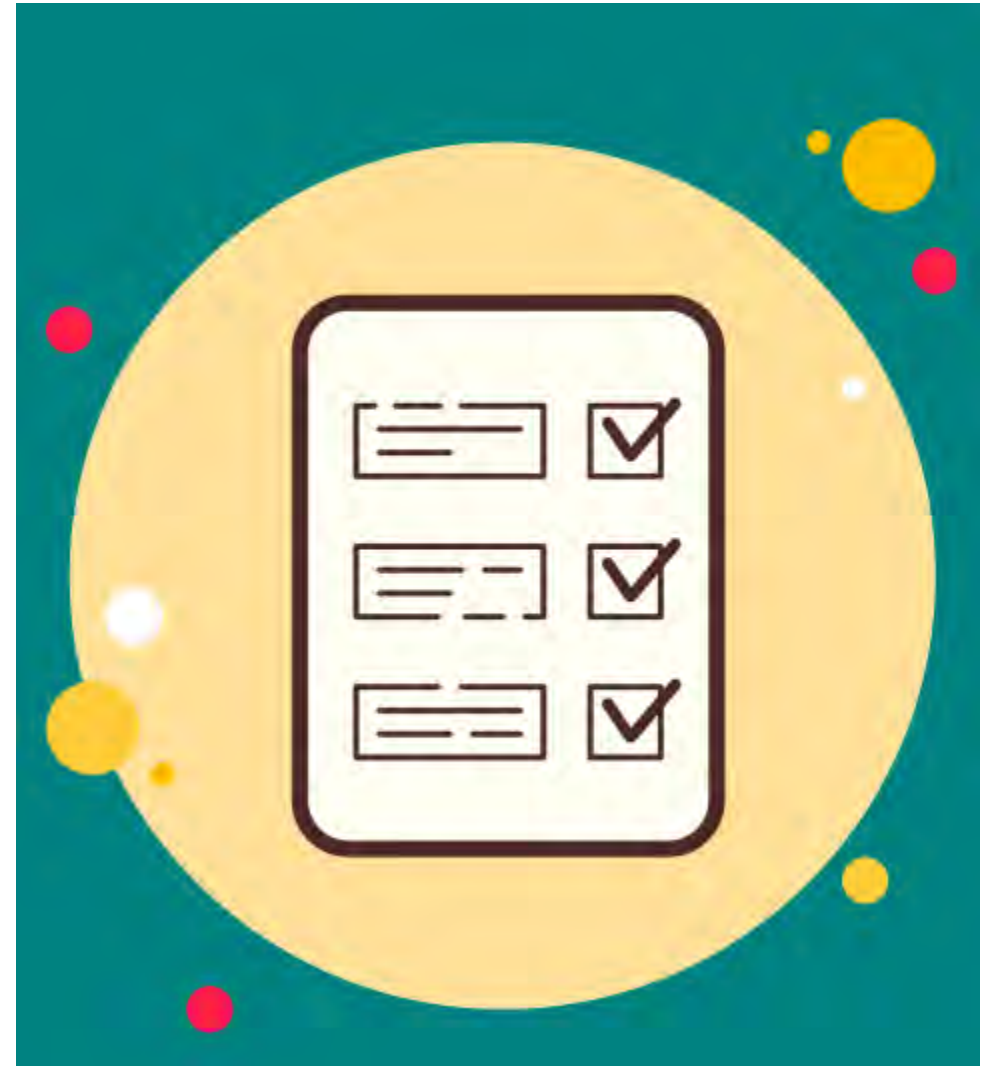

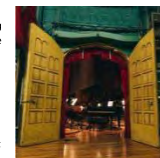
Little Kids Concerts

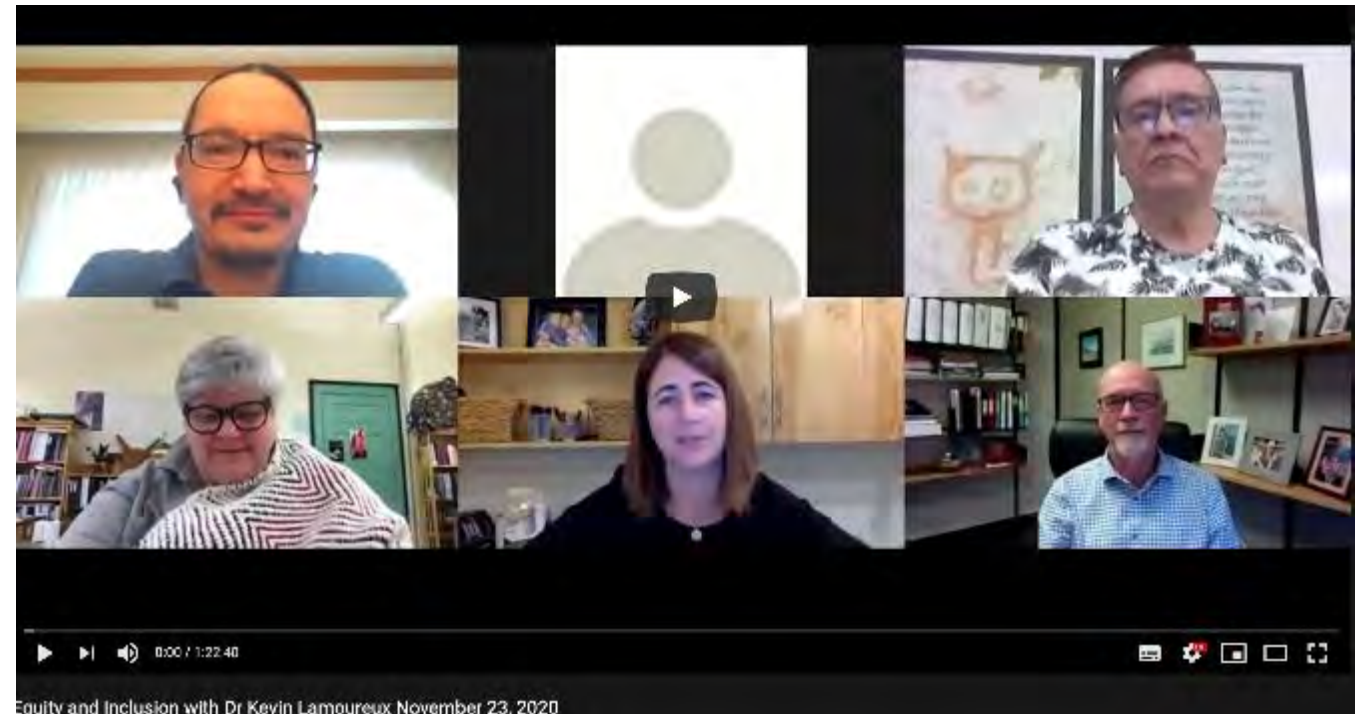
