Seamless Day is a unique program that provides before and after school care for students in Kindergarten and Grade One. The students are able to stay in the same care, play-based environment throughout the day. This allows the educators to better meet the needs of the child and respond to their interests and "wonder". The term of a session includes classroom before and after school children and educators. With minimum transition for the students, and being in close contact for the educators, students will have a consistent and secure environment.

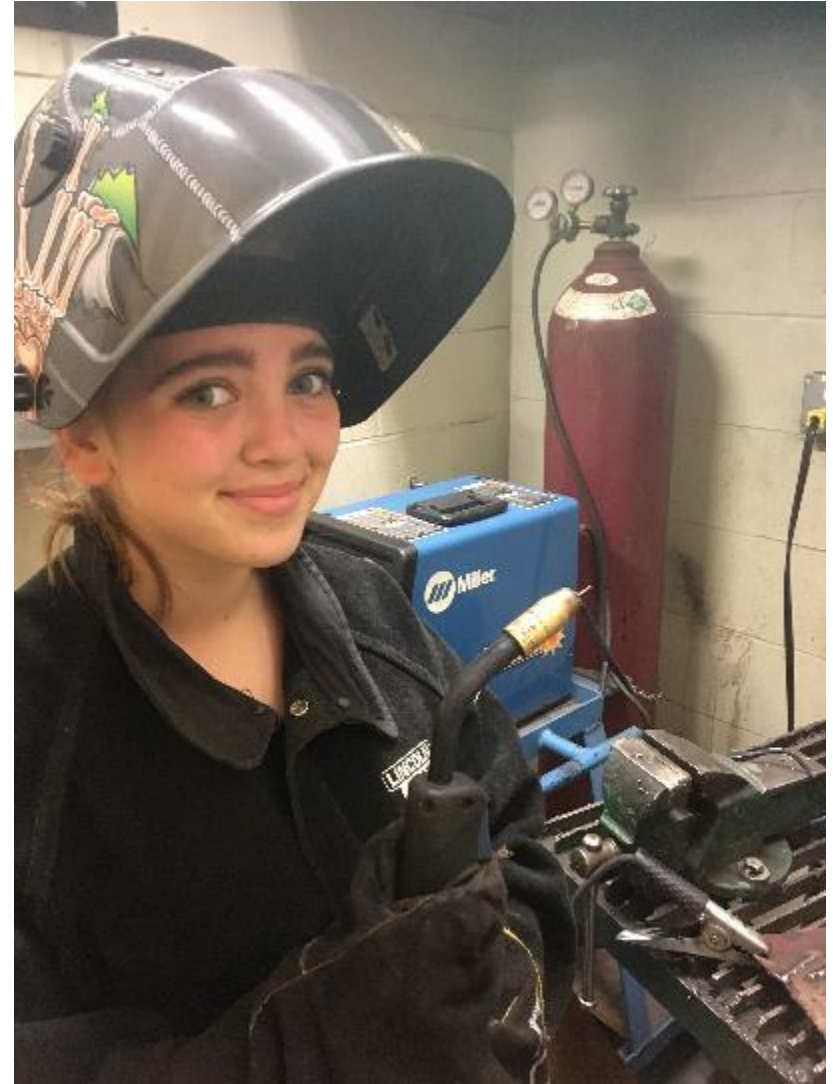

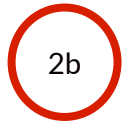
