SD46 ANNOUNCES EDUCATIONAL LEADERSHIP ASSIGNMENTS FOR THE 2022-2023 SCHOOL YEAR

SUNSHINE COAST, BRITISH COLUMBIA – School District 46 (SD46) is pleased to share the principal, vice-principal and district position assignments for the upcoming school year.

The changes for next year are:

- Desiree Harris will be vice-principal at Chatelech Secondary;
- Jeff Marshall will be vice-principal at Elphinstone Secondary, following Sue Bailey's decision to return to teaching;
- Olwen Cowan will be principal at West Sechelt Elementary;
- Lia Cuccurullo will be principal at Cedar Grove Elementary; and
- Rae-dene Pednaud will be principal at Davis Bay Elementary, following Ursula Hardwick's decision to return to teaching.



We welcome **Desiree Harris** to the leadership role of vice-principal at Chatelech Secondary! After completing her teaching degree in Surrey BC, Desiree moved to Shanghai, China where she taught at an A-Level International high school for three years. She then taught at the high school level in Perth, Australia for four years before returning to Canada where she taught at a high school in Langley for another four years. Desiree joined SD46 as a teacher in the Indigenous Education

Learning Team, and has most recently been working as a vice-principal at Elphinstone Secondary. Desiree is very grateful to be able to work and live here on the traditional unceded territories of the shishálh and Skwxwú7mesh Nations. Harris commented, "It has been such a pleasure to work with the Indigenous Education Team and the Elphinstone community this past school year. I am thrilled to be joining Chatelech Secondary next school year and I feel honoured to get to work and learn alongside the Chatelech community. I'm very excited to meet all the staff, students, and families!"



Jeff Marshall will be joining the leadership team at Elphinstone Secondary as vice-principal. Mr. Marshall has been principal at West Sechelt Elementary since 2019 and at Kinnikinnick Elementary before that. He has also been an elementary and secondary teacher at Kinnikinnick and Roberts Creek Elementary and Chatelech and Pender Harbour Secondary since 1999. He previously taught in First Nations schools in BC and Quebec. "I look forward to joining the team at

Elphinstone and returning to my secondary school roots. I would like to thank the West Sechelt community who have been so generous in their support over the past four years. Collaborating to construct the school expansion has been one of the highlights of my career," said Mr. Marshall.



Sue Bailey has been at Elphinstone Secondary since 2009. Most of that time she was a counsellor, but she has been the vice-principal since 2020 and has stepped into the role of principal since March of this year. Ms. Bailey will be returning to teaching next year and shared the following statement, "I have really loved Elphinstone Secondary and all the amazing students, staff, and families I have been able to work with all these years. While I've learned so much in my new role and have been grateful

for this opportunity, I have realized that it's not a fit for me. I know we'll have an awesome finish to this year, and I'm so excited to return to counselling for next year."




Grove school for a year of magnetic learning starting September 2022!" commented Ms. Cuccurullo.
