55 Presiding Officers

- A Chair and a Vice-Chair shall be elected annually, at the first public meeting of the Board in November, according to the procedure outlined in Bylaw Error! Reference source not found. During the second, third and fourth years of the Board's term of office, the elections will occur as the last item of business at the November public meeting.
- 55.2 The Board may elect a new Chair and/or Vice-Chair at any time.
- If the Chair is absent or unable to act, the Vice-Chair shall preside at meetings of the Board. If the Vice-Chair is also absent or unable to act, the members present shall elect one of their number to preside at the meeting by show of hands.
- The Chair may vacate the chair to enter debate or propose or second a motion, in which case the Vice-Chair, if present, or another member appointed by the Chair shall preside until the issue is disposed of (which should seldom be done).
