## 1ST DAY BUSSING

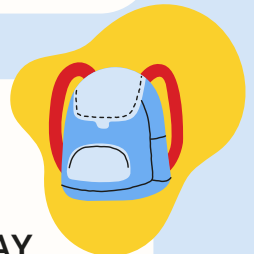
School bus services for the first day will reflect the start and end time changes.

## BUSSING

- Students registered for bussing last school year will automatically keep their same route, stop, and schedule for the 2024-25 year, no confirmation is needed.
- **ONLY (re)-register** if your child's school or home address has changed.
- If you have completed a **NEW 2024-25** bus registration for your child, you should have received a confirmation email from Diversified Transportation with the route details.

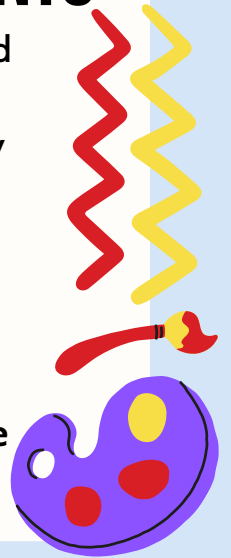
